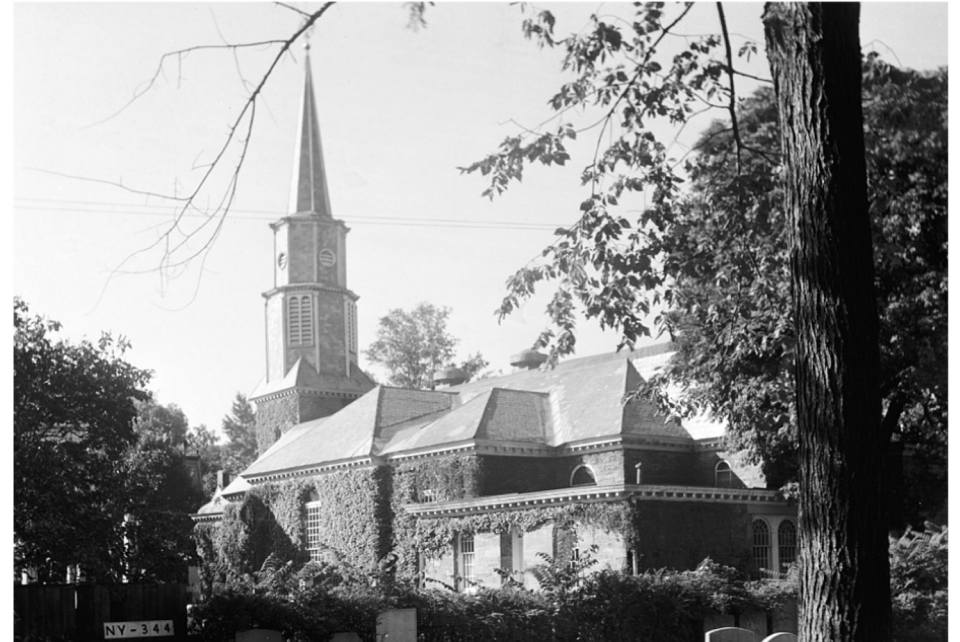
Looking Ahead
