Parish Outreach

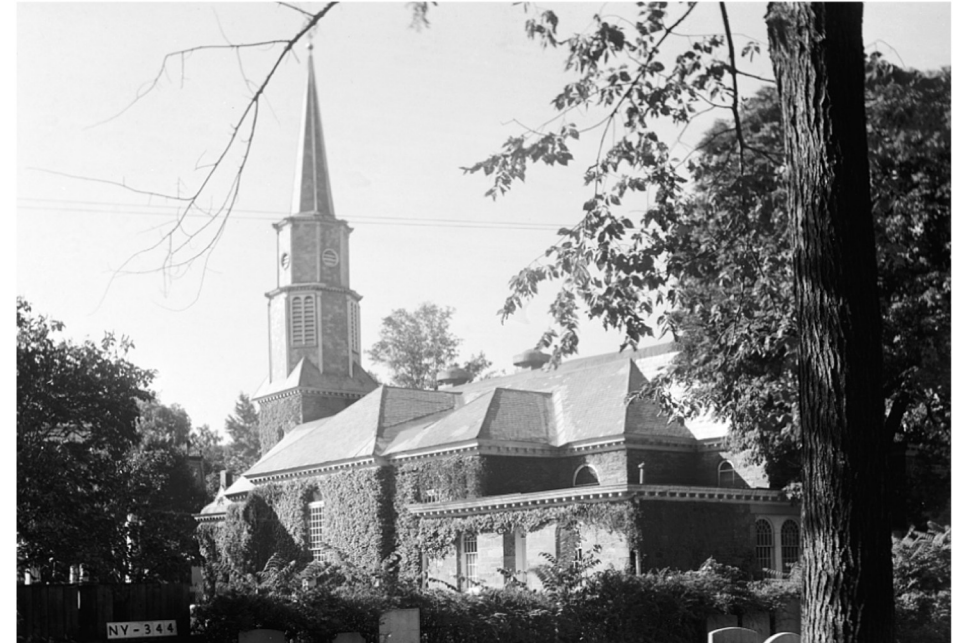
